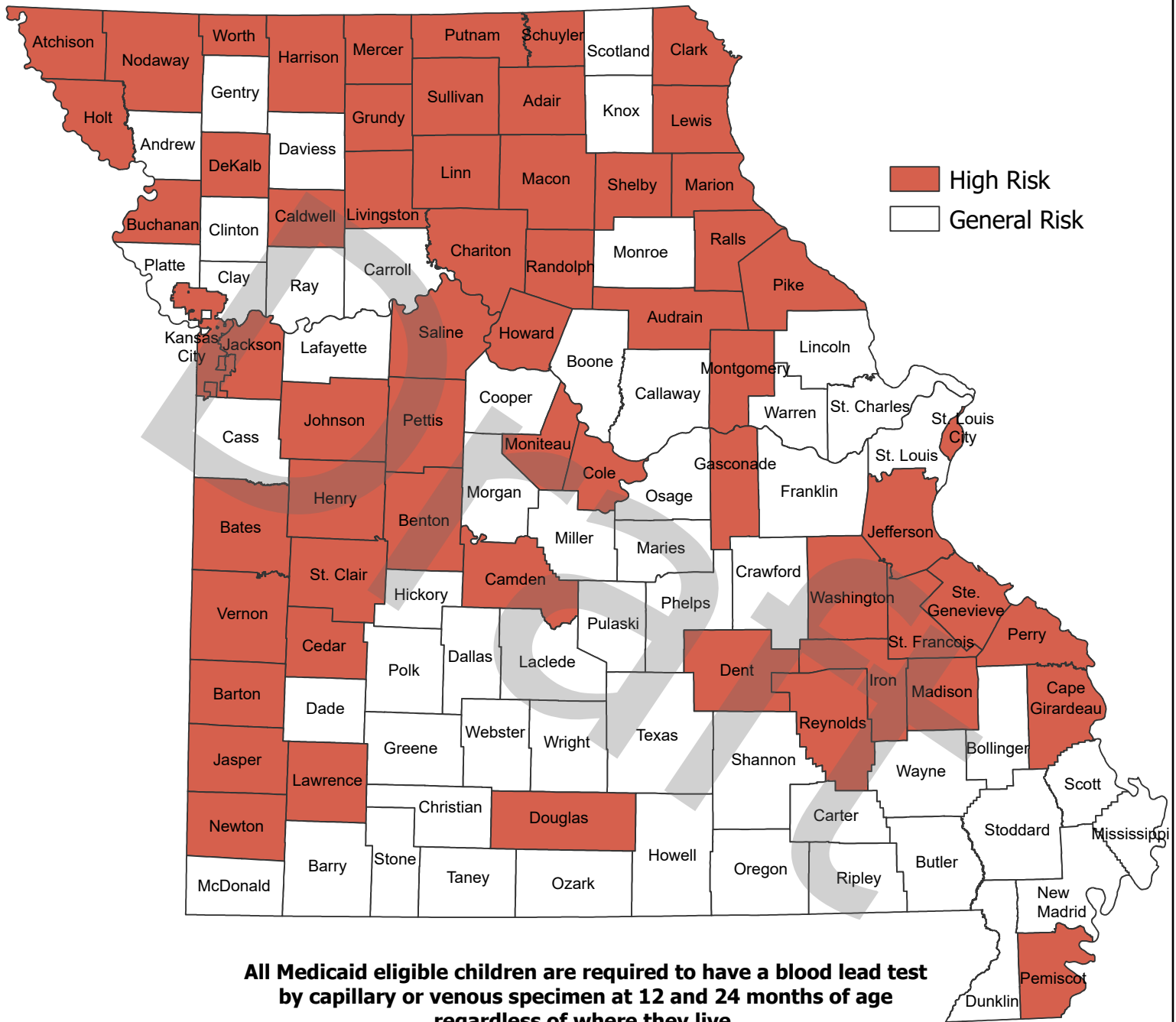


Annual Childhood Lead Testing Requirements



All Medicaid eligible children are required to have a blood lead test by capillary or venous specimen at 12 and 24 months of age regardless of where they live.

High Risk- Annual blood lead testing by capillary or venous specimen is required for every child under 6 years of age living in or visiting a high risk county for 10 hours a week or more.

General Risk- All children between 6 months to 6 years of age must be screened on an annual basis using the HCY Lead Risk Assessment Guide questionnaire. The child will require a blood lead test by capillary or venous specimen if a positive response is received on the questionnaire.
