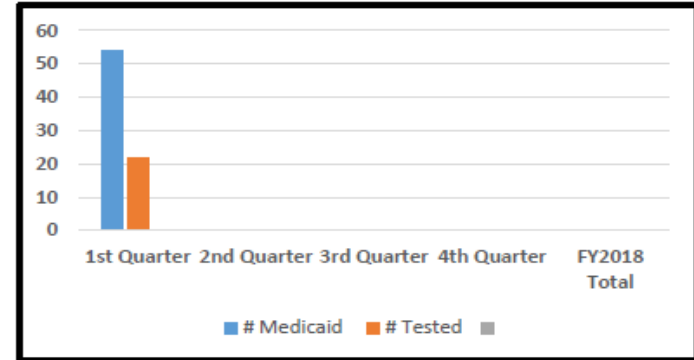

 - 3-5 years if not previously tested.

- 00% of children with lead poisoning in Missouri are enrolled in Medicaid.
